BIG CHANGES FOR THIS YEAR

Last year, the location of the tents was moved to the main road leading to the carnival. This gave us heavier exposure and made the show much more lucrative for the exhibitors. We will do the same again this year, and again will have to unload quickly and pack up only after everything has been taken down. We have to be very careful not to block the road. Also, no nails or stakes may be hammered into the street or concrete, so, bring weights and/or sandbags.

DIRECTIONS

Brook Run Park is located at 4770 N. Peachtree Road.

From the East on 285, take Exit 30 (North Peachtree Road). At the bottom of the ramp, take a right onto N. Peachtree. The entrance to the park will be on the left shortly past Peachtree Middle School.

From the west on 285, take exit 30 (Chamblee Dunwoody Road). Continue straight across the intersection onto Savoy Drive. At the second right, take a left onto N. Peachtree Road. The entrance to the park will be on the left just past Peachtree Middle School.

The DUNWOODY ARTS AND CRAFTS GUILD invites you to apply for participation in our show this Spring at Brook Run Park. This will be our 37th year of successful show promotions in the Atlanta area.

The Dunwoody Arts and Crafts Guild's spring show will be held again at the Brook Run Park in conjunction with Lemonade Days, a project of the Dunwoody Preservation Trust. Both groups do extensive advertising throughout the area and this merger is working out to be a great benefit to all concerned.

Brook Run is a very nice facility, which has been purchased by DeKalb County. Many plans are in the works for development of this property for the use of the surrounding communities. The Children's Playground was completed in the fall of 2005 and is enjoying heavy participation, as is the new skate board park and dog park.

This year, the Preservation Trust has expanded the size of the Carnival, which will be held April 15 – 18 (the show is the 17th and 18th). Again this year, there will be pony rides, and a petting zoo, and the food booths will be incorporated into the carnival area.

We will have snacks and drinks both mornings prior to the show time.

We appreciate your loyalty to the Dunwoody Guild in the past, and hope that you will consider joining us in this venture.

1. **JURYING:** By 3 photos (be sure to put your name on these) with one of the display or enough to show everything you will be selling. **Only one category per booth and staying within your category is a must.** You will be asked to remove any non-juried items from your booth. SASE (self-addressed, stamped envelope) required. Artists/crafters are selected on creativity and quality, and **we expect the artist/crafter to accompany their own work.** Your booth must be manned at all times. Space assignments are non-transferable and *no fees will be refunded after acceptance in the show.* Previous participation in Guild-sponsored shows does not guarantee future acceptance.
2. **CHILDREN:** Due to Show safety considerations, children are not allowed to accompany exhibitors. This does not apply to teenagers who are coming to help with selling.
3. **ACCEPTABLE CATEGORIES:** Our Guild strives to present a show well-rounded in quality arts and crafts. For this reason we try to place exhibitors so they are not conflicting with one another. Categories acceptable for all shows are painting, drawing, sculpture, pottery, photography, needlecraft, weaving, glass, plants, natural & dried arrangements, silk arrangements, and other approved crafts. No unfinished wood, kits, commercial items or buy-sell items may be allowed. **All crafts must be made by the artist.**
4. **DRESS CODE:** Dress appropriately - no cut-offs, short shorts, low cut tops, ragged jeans, halter tops etc. This is a business atmosphere and should be handled accordingly.

5. **GOOD HOUSEKEEPING:** Booth must be kept clean at all times. Exhibitor is responsible for disposing of all trash and debris. All personal items should be kept out of sight.

6. **SIGNS:** No sale signs, markdown signs or discounted signs of any kind will be allowed. Business cards may be distributed. No soliciting.

7. **TAXES:** Each exhibitor is responsible for his own taxes---7% in Dekalb.

8. **DISPLAY: Tables & Chairs:** Please bring your own display materials. All tables should be draped to the floor on all sides. No sheets allowed.

9. **QUESTIONS:** All questions should be directed to members of the show committee or members of the Dunwoody Arts & Crafts Guild.

Hours are 10:00 AM - 5:00 PM on SATURDAY, rain or shine. Times on Sunday are 10:00 AM to 5:00 PM. Check-in with Bonnie or Anne is from 10 - 7 PM FRIDAY night or 7:00 - 9:30 AM on SATURDAY morning. Because we're setting up in the street, we'll need for everyone to unload quickly and then move their vehicle to the parking area. Security is provided on both FRIDAY and SATURDAY nights by the Guild. The Dunwoody Arts & Crafts Guild assumes no responsibility or liability for any injury, loss or damage to any exhibitor or his work for any cause, even though every precaution will be taken to protect your property.

Some of Costco's and Sam's EZ-UP tents come with only 3 sides. Please secure the 4th side using a tarp or plastic sheet. Please bring 10 X 10 **WHITE** tents only.

Take-down is after 5 PM on SUNDAY. Anyone taking down early will not be asked to future shows.

Spaces are 10 x 12 so you'll have a little extra room.

No electricity is available.

Food and drink are to be handled discreetly.

All vehicles must be moved to a back parking area, which will be indicated to you on arrival. **THIS MUST BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.** No trailers are to be left in the main parking lot. No cars or vans are to be moved back into the show area until 5 PM.

We hope you will be with us at the Brook Run Lemonade Days. The Preservation Trust is pleased to have us there, and we will continue to do the same extensive advertising, which we have always done.
